

Another chance to buy at Westhaven

Westhaven has been a very successful development which Lyngrove Developments Limited built in Dublin 15. This weekend the second phase goes on the market – an additional 60 three-bed semi-detached houses with all the impressive original features that made these houses just a bit different from the norm.

Space is the most important feature here – the stairwell is located in the centre of the house and the added space has been incorporated into the sitting

room which is a very good size. There is a deep bay window which looks very well and purchasers have a £350 fireplace allowance. The kitchen/dining room stretches across the back of the house and there is a patio door leading outside.

There are two different house types and in one – The Haven – there is a utility room plumbed for washing machine. This space in the other house type – The Brook – is used as a store.

Upstairs, there are three bedrooms, two with built-

in wardrobes and, in The Brook, the master bedroom has an en-suite facility. Central heating here is by gas fired radiators and the houses are wired for alarm. There are white aluminium double glazed windows and the hardwood front door comes with three-point locking system. The houses are piped for a natural gas fire.

Convenience is a major factor when choosing a house and Westhaven is close to the village of Clonsilla, and schools for all ages are within walking distance – the new Community College here is one of the most advanced in Europe. The new Blanchardstown Shopping Centre, due to open this year, will be within easy reach and the No 39 Cityswift bus comes every six minutes.
